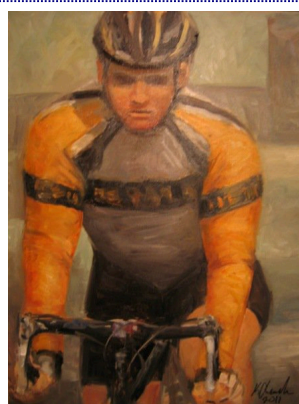
International Film Trailer Festival

The TW Art Exhibition and Auction was a successful awareness strategy. Several hundred visitors attended the exhibit during the 3 weeks it was open. Several artists expressed interest in helping TW by providing paintings that can be presented as gifts to the hospitals or other venues along the 2012 GTD trip. More information forthcoming.

TW Ride Across the Country 2012

The Go The Distance 2012 (GTD2012) route planning is 80% complete. The event will cover over 3400 miles between San Francisco, CA, and Boston, MA, from Sunday, June 24th through Tuesday, July 3rd. Major cities on the route will include Sacramento, Reno, Salt Lake City, Denver, Kansas City, St. Louis, Indianapolis, Dayton, Pittsburgh, and Hartford.

Team Will Receives \$10,000 Grant from Intel Corporation

A multitude of inspirational and dedicated Intel employees contributed their time and energy to Team Will in 2010, garnering a grant from Intel Corporation in the amount of \$10,000. Intel encourages employees to engage in outreach and volunteerism and supports employees' giving their time and talent to qualified non-profits. Not only did Team Will, along with families & hospitals across the country benefit from their time, but also received a generous check through the Intel Involved Matching Grant Program.

Throughout 2010, 15 Intel volunteers contributed 1000+ volunteer hours to support TW's cause of ending childhood cancer. Efforts were largely focused on the bi-annual "Breakaway" event in which the team rides across the country to promote awareness of pediatric cancer. In addition to a multitude of planning meetings, volunteers developed/disseminated press briefings, set up WiFi infrastructure for team vans, supported web updates during the event (so viewers could actively track the teams going cross-country), participated as drivers, and most importantly were advocates as the teams crossed the country visiting hospitals and participating in rallies along the way. We also have one Intel employee - 3 time event participant, John Depew, on the Board of Directors as well.

Team Will is very grateful for their efforts and Intel's volunteer matching grant program and look forward to continued engagement with these volunteers throughout 2011.

Note: In addition to Team Will's Grant, checks were also distributed to the Foundation for Children with Cancer and the Ronald McDonald house of Northern California as a result of these volunteers' effort.
